Rules and Regulations:

- All participants are to obey any and all National Traffic Department rules, laws, signs, markings, etc. and any and all National Traffic Department Officials at all times during the event and along the route from Johannesburg to Durban.
- All participants are to adhere to the required speed limit as set by the National Traffic Department at all times during the event and along the route from Johannesburg to Durban.
- Any dangerous or reckless driving, whether it endangers other road users or not is strictly prohibited at all times and any transgressors will be dealt with in the appropriate manner.
- All vehicles used in the event are to be in a roadworthy condition and any vehicles that are suspected of not being in a roadworthy condition may be restricted from participating in the event.
- All vehicles are required to carry basic spares such as a spare wheel, car jack and a wheel spanner.
- Drivers of participating vehicles are responsible for the comfort, safety and behaviour of their passengers and need to ensure that they abide by the rules and regulations of the event at all times.
- Respect and courtesy will be given to all other road users by all participants at all times remember that we are representing the club and need to uphold its name.
- A number of vehicles will be designated as lead or sweep vehicles and all participants are to obey any instructions given by the drivers of these vehicles at all times during the event and along the route from Johannesburg to Durban.
- A sweep vehicle will carry basic mechanical spares and a first aid kit but for use in the unlikely event of a breakdown or medical emergency.
- The lead vehicle will carry details of all participants, such as names, contact details, etc. and any other important information such as medical conditions need to be communicated to the lead vehicle.
- Designated stops along the route will be communicated to all participants closer to the event, but all participants are required to stop at these designated stops.
- The main convoy will not stop for any vehicle that has to stop for any reason whatsoever. The sweep vehicle will stop with any vehicle that requires stopping and will communicate with the lead vehicle to make arrangements for catching up with the main convoy, either by catching up on route or meeting at the next designated stop.
- Video and still camera footage will be taken throughout the event and this will be coordinated by the clubs official photographers. (All photographers welcome)
- Participants are more than welcome to take their own video and still camera footage, provided it does not
 interfere with the running of the event, break any traffic laws or regulations or interfere with other road
 users.

Indemnity:

- The Participant agrees to indemnify, hold harmless The Volkswagen Club of South Africa and its officers, sponsors and representatives from and against the following damages, losses and liabilities arising from or as a result of the negligence or fault of the Participant:
- Any Liability with regard to claims by governmental authorities or others for non-compliance by the Participant with any Act of Parliament, law, ordinance, regulation or by-law made by a lawful authority.
